
QSL Managers Message

First, I want to offer my congratulations to all the club members who have operated at our club events over the years. You helped us earn this award...

Next, I want to recognize one of our members...James Frank, KW5CW. He received this award from the Parks on the Air program, POTA.

Finally, I want to remind everyone that our next special event is coming up in October. The Eisenhower Birthday Special Event will be held from October 9 until October 17. We'll be using these 10 call signs...

The management of the Eisenhower Birthplace State Historical Site in Denison, TX has invited the club to participate in their birthday celebration of Ike's birthday on October 9th at the birthplace and the club has accepted their invitation. We'll set up the club's radio and antenna and use it to make some contacts for our special event and give many of our newer members an opportunity to experience HF radio and what it is like to make some contacts on the air. I will also set up my mobile station in my vehicle in the parking lot and make some contacts for the special event. Everyone is encouraged to come out and participate and spend some time with the operators using the club's radio or my radio to find out what HF radio is all about. If you are a Technician license holder and don't know if you want to invest the time and money to get involved with HF radio this will be a perfect opportunity for you to get some first-hand experience and knowledge to help you make that decision.

If you are not able to attend on October 9, I plan on operating with my mobile station out at the park on many days during the event. Let me know when you can attend and I'll be there to work with you.

I want to remind everyone...operators who have signed up for our 1X1 call signs and everyone else, that many folks still have to work for a living and won't be using their call signs all the time. If you are an operator and know that you won't be on the air a certain day or time let me know and we'll let someone else use the call sign. Club members who aren't assigned a call sign and want to participate...let me know and I'll let you use a call sign that isn't be used right now.

Remember, you can operate any time you want...use any band...use any mode you want. You don't have to go to a POTA park to operate...you can operate from home...or wherever. There are only 2 rules...

You must follow the band plan for the license you hold.

You must send your log of the contacts you make to me at the end of the event.

Last year we made over 5000 contacts during the Eisenhower Special Event using 3 call signs...

W5I, W5K, W5E

This year I'm hoping we'll make 10000 contacts using 10 call signs. Can we, do it???

We'll find out.

Thanks everyone and remember...no matter what you do in the hobby...have fun!



The Eisenhower Birthday Special Event – October 9th -17th Nomination of Club Officers for 2022

Club Meeting Presentation October 19th – Go-Kits with a Demonstration

As the saying goes, here comes the 'meat and potatoes' of the special events this year with the Eisenhower Birthday Special Event just around the corner. Ike was actually born on October 14, 1890. Can you imagine how many contacts the club will make this year as the club will be using not just one call, but TEN 1x1 calls to make contacts for an entire week. It all starts out at the Eisenhower Birthplace on October 9th, as the club received and has accepted an invitation to attend. All members are encouraged to be there and see what the event is all about and to tour the birth home of President Dwight Eisenhower. But October 9th is just the beginning. After the activities end at the Eisenhower birthplace on that day, club members and non-club members alike will continue making contacts through October 17th. Last year, the club made a little over 5000 contacts, but I can safely say the expected number of contacts I expect the club will make this year will at least double the number of contacts made last year. My prediction is at least 10,000 contacts to be made in 2021. This is a special event that many of us have been waiting to take part in for months. If you presently are not one of the people that have been designated to use one of the ten specific calls that will be used, you can be put on a backup list, or at any time you can contact Lee – N5SLY at 903-818-7463 or at n5sly@arrl.net and indicate to him the date and time when you would like to operate and be available at that time. Any member or non-member that would like to operate in the event should schedule time to operate with Lee. He will make it happen. Also, designated operators should inform Lee when they know specifically that they cannot operate so someone else can take the spot while you are at work or doing something else besides radio.

At the October meeting, the club will nominate four people that can become the new officers for the club in 2022. At the November meeting, the officers will be formally elected to serve in 2022. So, it's pretty important for all of the GCARC members to be there that can attend in October for the nominations. All positions are open... President, Vice-President, Secretary and Treasurer. It is my responsibility as Director at Large, that the turnover from the old officers to the new officers take place in a seamless fashion. But first, we must get a few people elected. So, I'm hoping that the club has a great turnout of members for the October meeting.

For me, I get to put on the next Presentation at the October club meeting. It will be kept to no longer than 30 minutes, because as just mentioned, there are officer nominations to follow. For years, I've participated in GCARC activities, namely Winter Field Day, Summer Field Day and Special events. I've always had to carry the bulk of my home station with me to these events, and it becomes tiring and cumbersome. Finally, I put together a special go-kit, not very light, but contains everything I need to run Amateur Radio from just about anywhere with emergency power. It takes about 5-10 minutes to set up so I'm ready to transmit, so I'll talk about the go-kit and

then make a few digital contacts with it right from Mariachi's. The live demonstration will prove to be very interesting. There will be a slide show, a short talk and then the demo. It should be fun! We can continue operating after the meeting if it's not too late.
