QSL Managers Message

Here are the answers for the Quiz that was published in last month's newsletter.

1. The first "rule" of the DX Code of Conduct is, "I will listen, listen and then listen again before calling."
2. It is OK to use local time in your log book to record the contacts you make. False, you must use ZULU time, UTC Universal Time, or GMT Greenwich Mean Time

C. Sierra

Two useful knots for ham radio operators to use when erecting a vertical antenna are the Clove Hitch and the Taught Line Hitch.

Regarding Band Conditions using Solar-Terrestrial Data the SFI and SN numbers are better when they are Higher. The A & K numbers are better when they are Lower.

According to the DX Code of Conduct I will send only my suffix when calling another station to shorten how much information I transmit. False, always say your complete call sign.

Transceivers can send and receive radio signals at the same time. False. Radios either receive or transmit. They cannot do both at the same time. I'm amazed at how many hams talk at the same time as the other station. What are they thinking???

You must get a Signal Report from another station to have a valid contact. False, although everyone wants to get a Signal Report all 3rd Party QSL service providers don't require a Signal Report to Confirm a contact.

QRZ means? Who is calling me?

What is a Grid Square? A location on Earth. Another way of describing Longitude and Latitude. Easier to understand than Degrees, Minutes and Seconds.



I posted a survey on Facebook and asked about how long our Special Events should last. The results are in and 57% of those that took the survey felt that 7 days was the right length.... Saturday – Friday. 14% felt that 9 days was the right length (what we do now) and 28% felt that we should only have the events for 2 days. Our last Special Event is coming up in October and it is scheduled to last for 9 days. But I'd like to propose that next year we shorten all our Special Events to 7 days...Saturday, 0000z – Friday, 2359z. What say you?

I have volunteered to be the Team Leader for the VE Testing Group for the Grayson County ARC. We'll start to have testing available in October before our club meetings and every month except for December. If you want to upgrade your license or know someone who wants to get their Amateur Radio License, you'll be able to take the test now easily before a club meeting. So... start studying!

I haven't been doing a lot of POTA, (Parks on The Air) Activation's lately because it has been too darn hot here in Texas. Hope to get more active when it cools off in the fall. Will keep you posted on Facebook.

Finally, our next special event is coming upon us fast. The Eisenhower Birthday Special Event runs from October 14, 2023, 0000z – October 22, 2023, 2359z. Again, this year we'll be using 10 1X1 call signs. We have a great bunch of guest operators who will be participating this year. They are...

Upcoming Eisenhower Event to Provide Certificates

The Eisenhower Special Event is less than a month away, and it will be a great operating event this year. There are stations across the country using the 1x1 special calls that will be used for the event. There will be a little twist regarding the activity this year, as the club will provide certificates. If GCARC members would like to operate using a special 1x1 callsign, they can use **W5R** as the call they would use during the event. Your personal license privileges must be honored when using a special event call. Like the Route 66 and the 13 Colonies Special Event that have been held for the last several years now that provide certificates to operators, the GCARC has opted into the upcoming event with the addition of providing certificates to anyone who works at least one of the Special Event stations. Lee has always done a fantastic job coordinating all the special events throughout the years, but this year it will take a coordinated effort to get the certificates out to operators. This is the first time the club is offering certificates to operators, and hopefully the mailing of certificates will go smoothly. During the contest and especially after the conclusion, the club can receive a \$5 donation to the club from people who want the certificate. The fee is NOT Mandatory. The monies received are considered a donation, so sending the funds will be encouraged by the writeup on the 1x1 QRZ web pages which should appear after the upcoming meeting on September 19th. A logging form and a submission form will be provided that operators can use during the event and use to submit for the certificate, posted on QRZ.com.
