Recently, Hurricane Helene and Milton wreaked havoc across the southeastern United States, especially in North Carolina, Georgia and Florida. The storms caused massive flooding, tornados and widespread power outages, and disrupted modern communication systems like cellular and internet networks. In the face of these challenges, amateur (ham) radio operators played a crucial role in maintaining communication, particularly in areas cut off from regular services.

Ham operators coordinated welfare checks, relayed emergency messages, and provided updates on road conditions for families trying to reach loved ones. They also assisted with logistics for relief efforts, working with volunteer pilots and military units to coordinate the delivery of supplies to isolated communities. Their ability to operate independently of modern infrastructure proved invaluable when conventional methods failed.

In short, ham radio demonstrated its enduring value as a reliable communication tool during disasters like Hurricane Helene and Milton. Thank you to all of the operators out there who helped those in need!


Also don't forget the Christmas party which will be in place of the December club meeting. It is the last event of the year.
