## DIRECTIONS to Mells Grill in Denison, Texas

It is easy to find. As you travel along Spur Rt. 503 – S. Eisenhower Parkway to Denison from I-75 which becomes S. Austin Avenue as you enter Denison, you will come to the downtown area. At the Whataburger at the corner at West Crawford Street in Denison, make a left turn on W. Crawford Street and just drive 4 blocks to Mells Grill which is on the right corner of S. Mirick Ave and Crawford. Immediately to the left at Mirick Ave on Crawford is the parking lot. Walk in the door across the street from your parking space to Mells Grill facing Crawford and join in on the fun.
