## Sunday Information Net SCRIPT

### INTRODUCTION

Good evening this is XXXX, my name is XXX. I am now activating the Grayson County Amateur Radio Club Information Net on the Sherman, TX W5RVT 147.000 repeater. Our backup repeater will be the W5RVT 147.280. I am your Net Control Operator for tonight's net. Welcome to all that have decided to get on the air tonight.

### CALL FOR EMERGENCY TRAFFIC

If there are any stations with emergency or priority traffic, please come now. (Handle emergency and priority traffic, if any.) --- No Emergency or Priority traffic has been heard. If you have an emergency or priority message during the Net, please call BREAK – BREAK for immediate acknowledgment by Net Control.

### CALL FOR BACKUP NET CONTROL OPERATOR

Is anyone willing to act as the Backup Net Control Operator? Please come now.

### SPONSOR AND PURPOSE

The GCARC was established in part to:

- provide trained, licensed radio operators to support local community and organizational activities, and to assist federal, state, county, and local agencies during times of emergency – through ARES and RACES when needed and,
- conduct activities that facilitate the exchange of information, as well as promote radio knowledge and comradery within the Amateur Radio and local communities.

### NET PROTOCOL

1. You do not have to be a member of the GCARC radio club to participate in this Net.
2. This is a directed general conversation net. Its purpose is to share information about club events, discuss technical topics, ask technical/non-technical questions and have a general round table discussion about the Net Control Operator's selected topic.
3. At the end of the round table SWAP MEET session will be conducted.
4. If you are interested in serving as net control for one of our nets contact me or one of the club officers and we will work you into the net schedule.
5. This is directed Net.
  - a. Checking-in
  - b. In groups of three please give your call sign phonetically followed by your first name, please indicate if you are short-time (just in for the count, if you so indicate, you will not be called to for comment during the round table discussion).

- c. Please call for a “recheck” and wait to be recognized by net control if you wish to make a comment at any time prior to or after being called during the round table discussion.
6. I will now take check-ins in groups of three starting with our Operators on Echolink – log check-ins and repeat back call sign and name, repeat until no check-ins heard
7. Welcome, and thank you to all those who have checked in.
  - a. Club News and Announcements
    - i. You may ask for one of the club board members to make these announcements
  - b. General Announcements
    - i. The Grayson County ARES Net meets on the 2nd & 4th Sundays of each month @ 8PM on this repeater. This is a directed ARES training net

  - c. This is XXXXX your net control operator and you are listening to the GCARC Information Net.

#### **ROUND TABLE SELECTED TOPIC DISCUSSION**

We will now recall all check-ins in the order received and ask for their comments about tonight’s topic

Okay I am at the end of my list, is there any more stations that would like to check in at this time if so please come now. PAUSE FOR ANY FURTHER LATE CHECK-IN'S and invite them to make their comments at this time.

#### **SWAP MEET**

Any station having items for the Swap Net, please come now with your call sign. PAUSE FOR CHECK-IN'S for Swap meet only. Re-call all stations that have items for the Swap Net.

#### **NET CLOSURE**
